

Our 8 stage oriental rug cleaning process is more thorough than any other carpet cleaning system. Over the years your rugs act like a filter trapping all kinds of dirt, dust, allergens and debris. Deep in the pile, it can't be removed by conventional vacuuming alone. If you wash the rug with shampoo the dirt turns to mud that sticks to the pile, it discolours the wool and is impossible to remove.



Our process -

- Gets rid of the grit and dust and make your rugs last longer.
- Flushes away years of dirt stuck to the pile to show the true colours
- Shakes out soil deep in the pile of your rug with a powerful vibro action
- Uses powerful specialist rug cleaning equipment for the best result
- Eco-Friendly **RugRevive** Cleans without using harsh detergents or brighteners

Our workshop has been equipped specifically to clean Oriental rugs. Powerful equipment achieves results that are simply not possible using conventional cleaning machines

The 8 stages

- 1 Power brush** - To lift flattened and matted pile
- 2 Rug dusting** - Our powerful RugBadger removes Bugs, Allergens, Dust and Grit
- 3 Pre-Wash** - Special stabilizing solution to break down water resistant soiling and make our RugRevive process even more effective.
- 4 RugRevive washing process** - RugRevive separates the soil from the pile and a 400psi jet flushes the dirt away in one cycle. Your rug is left almost dry.
- 5 More rug dusting** - This second stage rug dusting often removes more grit than the first
- 6 Fringes, stain removal and detailing** - Our custom-made fringe cleaning tool makes light work of dirty fringes and careful use of stain removers complete the clean
- 7 Rug Finishing** - Finishing rinse to set the pile and add a lustre to the rug
- 8 Rug drying** - Power drying with multiple Turbo Fans humidity and temperature control. Leaving your rugs absolutely dry.

Rug Repair & Restoration

A specialised rug repair and restoration service

We are able to fix broken side cords, re-fringe rugs, repair holes, re-weave and re-pile old or antique rugs and even re-build the corner of the rug that the dog has chewed! Advice and quotations can be arranged.

These photos show restoration work of an antique **Persian Malayer** carpet. The rug had many areas to restore; worst of all was one of its corners.



Torn and decayed from damp caused by a leaking flower pot. It happens more often than you think.

First the rug is cleaned and deodorized using our RugRevive washing process. This reveals the true colours that we have to work too.



The weak areas are cut away and new foundation warps are sewn in to the body of the rug.



The weft threads are inter-woven with the warps. Great care is needed to ensure the texture of the finished repair matches the original rug.



Carefully matching the colours of the new wool to that of the original rug the design is painstakingly reproduced by knotting the wool to the warp threads.



When the re-knotting is complete the pile is cut to the correct height. The nap is set by steaming and pressing the repair. Finally the side-cord is built up and over-sewn and the fringe made and secured
